- 3 p.m. Check In at the Aquatic Centre
- 1 p.m. Check Out Site must be cleared at this time
- · One picnic table per site
- Single family occupancy per campsite (Up to two units are allowed i.e. one RV & one dining tent etc.)
- Only two motor vehicles per site (All vehicles must display current registration)
- Quiet time is from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. This includes turning off generators. Staff are not on duty at this time. Please contact the Altona Police Dept. at 204-324-5353 if problems arise
- The Altona Campground is a short term camping facility, and does not offer seasonal or long term sites
- No person/s or camping unit is allowed to occupy the same campsite for more than 21 consecutive nights
- We reserve the right to move bookings to other sites at any time in order to make the best use of the campground facilities
- Pets must be leashed at all times Designated Off Leash are located behind the Millennium Exhibition
 Centre & on the SE corner of the Buffalo Creek Nature Pond
- Please be responsible for cleaning up after your pet
- Violent, aggressive or noncooperative behavior from campers (or their visitors) will not be tolerated
- Alcohol may be consumed only in the permit holder's camping unit or assigned site, in accordance with the Liquor Control Act. The smoking or vaping of cannabis, medicinal or non-medicinal is prohibited in all public spaces in the Town of Altona
- Sites must be kept in clean and tidy conditions. Guests are expected to dispose of garbage regularly and properly in the designated bins near the sewer dump
