



Seasonal Grounds Maintenance Gallery in the Park

The Town of Altona is looking for a mature, responsible, enthusiastic individual to take on the seasonal grounds maintenance work at the Gallery in the Park.

The Gallery in the Park is a heritage home turned art gallery and sculpture garden in Altona, Manitoba. It is open seasonally from June through to the end of September, and exhibits works by local, national and international artists. The growing sculpture garden contains many permanent pieces by local and international artists and is known as a jewel of our community.

Duties for this position include care of the following:

- Flower beds, planters, trees and shrubs
 - Planting, trimming/pruning, and watering as required
- Grass areas
 - Mowing, trimming and watering as required
- Fountain/Water Feature
 - Assist with initial cleaning & start up, periodic vacuuming of pools and canal, routine maintenance of pumps/bunker, assist with draining & winterizing
- Sprinkler System
 - Routine maintenance of sprinkler heads
- Pathways/Paved areas
 - Routine care of gravel pathways (raking, weeding, etc)

- Sweeping of brick pathways and patio as required
- Sculptures
 - Routine cleaning of sculptures
 - Annual waxing of all sculptures
- Gallery building
 - Occasional, pre-arranged assistance as requested

This contract requires an average of 22 hours per week, commencing May 4th and ending mid-September. Hours may vary, and additional time may be required prior to special events at the direction of the Recreation Foreman.
