Compost Bins

All compostable materials should be placed inside:

- Green compost cart (max weight of 130 lbs/cart).
 - Containers with molded handles without lids (max weight of 50 lbs/container).
 - Compostable bags, such as paper yard waste bags, (max weight of 35 lbs/bag).
- If your container includes non-compostable materials or large branches it will not be collected.

Recycling Bins

For pick up at the curb, all recyclable materials should be placed in:

- Blue recycling cart
- Any container that is clearly marked as recycling

E-Waste Drop Off

Blue Sky Opportunities recycling drop-off facility open 24/7. Located at 349 2nd Street NW

*There is no limit to the amount of compostable & recyclable materials that can be put out for collection per household.

*Compost & Recycling carts are numbered and must remain at the property to which they are assigned.



Garbage Collection

Residential dwellings are allowed 1 Garbage Bag or Container (30 Gallons / 114 Litres) per week. Any bags above the limit must have a garbage bag tag.

Garbage bag tags are available for \$2 each and may be purchased at the Altona Civic Centre. As per Workplace Health & Safety regulations, all garbage bags or containers must weigh less than 50 pounds.

Bulky Waste Collection

Do you have large items that need to be disposed of, but no way to transport them to the Waste Diversion Loop or the Waste Disposal Site?

The Town of Altona Public Works Department offers a Bulky Waste Pick-Up service by appointment.

You can purchase a Bulky Waste Pick-Up tag for \$30 each at the Town of Altona Administration Office from Monday – Friday, 8:30 am – 5 PM. At the time of purchase, your pick-up will be scheduled for the next available collection date. Up to 10 items can be collected per address during a single visit, but each item must be individually tagged.



Waste Diversion Loop

Items that can be dropped off FREE of charge during Landfill hours at the Waste Diversion Loop (Turn left before the scale at the Waste Disposal Site)

- Tires
- Scrap Metal
- Fluorescent
- Mattresses
- Propane Tanks
- Paint
- Batteries
- White Goods



Used Oil Recycling Depot

Engine oil, oil filters, used cooking oil, coolant & consumer DEF containers (4L) can be dropped off for free! Check in with landfill office to use.

Waste Disposal Site Rates by effective date	Jan 2023
Minimum Charge (up to 200kg)	\$16
Garbage (per metric tonne)	\$80
Clean shingles (not contaminated with other construction materials)	\$70
Clean Lumber/Fill (per metric tonne)	\$80
Branches/Brush	Free
Garbage from outside of Altona and Rhineland (per metric tonne)	\$100
